Course Overview & Topics:

Online university level course that touches upon the foundational topics of the Catholic Faith including: Our Desire for God, Divine Revelation & Response of Faith, God the Father, Jesus Christ, Scripture & Tradition, Evangelization & Conversion, and Prayer.

Students will examine these foundational topics using the Catechism of the Catholic Church as the chief source. Each topic introduces particular and important content in the Deposit of Faith. For example, under "Our Desire for God," students will look at the nature of the human person and what it means for the person to be made in the image and likeness of God; under "God the Father," students will explore the doctrine of Creation.
